Creating a herd is not a requirement for registration but to use many of the system's features you will need to have a herd. The first herd is free to register. You can register a herd at a later time

The herd prefix is your 'brand' and will prefix all of your animals' names - which are part of that herd. An animal's prefix never changes, even if sold to someone else

The herd code is tied to the member, not the animals, allowing people to search animals you own but maybe did not breed. It must be unique within the system and be between 2 and 6 characters

The herd prefix must be unique in the system and can be up to 16 characters
